Six are already in or are going into the workforce. Three completed the GEDO 2 Program to meet their requirements. Three seniors are on track to graduate at the end of the year. Three juniors are preparing to take the GED next school year to make up credits and prepare for the workforce through work release and/or YA in their senior year. Three juniors are identified as potentially graduating early next year with each having less than 5 credits to complete. Three juniors are now caught up on credits and are on the same pacing as their traditional peers.
