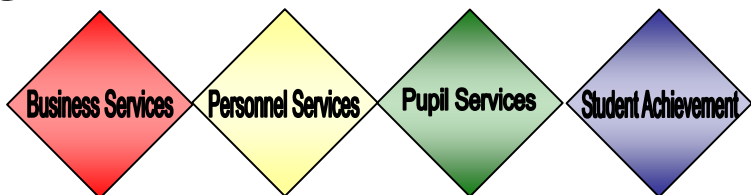

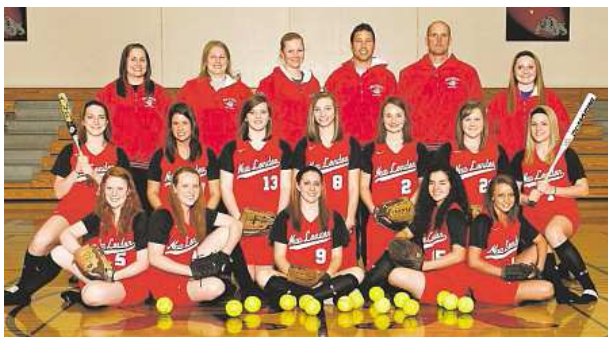
Student Athletes:

Project Lead the Way (PLTW) has recognized the School District of New London's pre-engineering program for excellence in science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) education. A certificate has been awarded for efforts at the Middle School and High School for the commitment to provide a rigorous STEM curriculum which is made available to **all** students.

2011-12 Registration:

We continue to work to refine registration processes to ensure efficiency for New London families. We encourage students who are new to the district to enroll at any time throughout the summer months at the building or district office.

Online registration will begin July 17 and serves the purpose of updating student records. Families are asked to complete the online record update prior to attending onsite registration sessions.

Elementary students will complete the registration process at their scheduled Open House sessions which include:

- *Readfield: August 30 – 4:30-6:00
- *Sugar Bush: August 30 – 4:00-5:30
- *Lincoln: August 31 – 4:00-5:30

Grade 5-12 students and their parents will attend one of the following registration sessions where pictures will be taken, fees paid and schedules provided:

- *Grades 5-12: August 9 and 17 at each school. Noon-7:00 pm
- *Grades 5-12: August 23 at the high school Noon-7:00 pm

Computers and staff will be available to assist parents who are not able to complete the online update prior to the onsite registration session.
