End of Quarter 3

The third quarter has come to a close. The high school runs on semesters, so you will not receive a report card for the third quarter. Grades will be updated for quarter three on Monday, April 8th, in Skyward. Parents are encouraged to regularly check Skyward for grades, missing assignments, and attendance updates. If you have questions regarding Skyward, please reach out to your child's teachers, counselor, or administrator.

Testing Wednesday

On Wednesday, April 10th, all 9th and 10th grade students will take the Pre ACT Assessment. This test is a required assessment for all 9th and 10th-grade students in the state of Wisconsin. It assesses students in the areas of English, Math, Reading, and Science.

11th and 12th-grade students do not report to school. They should be working on current assignments, assessments, studying, and reading.

Please note the following information for 9th and 10th graders:

1. This is a **full day** of school. Students will have classes after testing and are expected to stay in school.
2. Testing will take place from 7:50 a.m. - approximately 11:30 a.m.
3. Breakfast will be available for all students from 7:30 a.m. to 7:50 a.m.
4. Please make sure **students bring a charged Chromebook and a calculator**. If students do not have a calculator, the school will provide one.

Prom
