Scheduling for the 2022-2023 academic year has kicked off this week at the High School. By the end of the week we will have provided informational presentations to each grade level and opened up scheduling to your child. All students will have until **February 7th** to enter course requests and their alternate choices into Skyward for next year. After the scheduling window has closed, the school counselors will meet with your child individually to ensure they have a completed schedule that is ideal for them and their future. Finalized schedules will be released in August.

We have advised students to talk with their parents/guardians and include them in the scheduling process. Please have a conversation with your child regarding scheduling, as your positive influence, impact, and involvement is a critical element to their success. Parents should review the information and scheduling process in the course description guide that is included below. Students should be selecting courses that interest them, challenge them, lead to a career pathway or post-secondary goal, or meet a prerequisite for a class they may want to take in the future.
