To that end, the School District of New London is pleased to offer the Senior Tax Exchange Program. Senior citizens are given the opportunity to work in the district and receive a credit toward payment of property taxes.

Who Qualifies?

Any social security eligible senior citizen 62 years of age or older whose primary residences are in the School District of New London and who pay property taxes on these residences have the opportunity to work in the District in exchange for property tax credit.

Application Details

A STEP applicant indicates the type of volunteer work and the amount and dispersal of hours he/she desires. This information is matched with a staff member's request, which must be directly related to his/her primary area of responsibility. An interview will be scheduled with the STEP coordinator prior to joining the STEP Program.
