Payment for Ski & Snowboard Club

Payment for the trips can be made in 2 installments, see due dates on payment form. **Checks can be made out to NLHS.** Students must turn in all payments to the main office.

Cost

Attached you will find the sheet explaining the cost of the skiing or snowboarding and transportation. **ALL MEMBERS MUST RIDE THE BUS** If your child has his/her own equipment your cost will be less. There is no cost to the school district. The skiers/snowboarders pay for all fees including bus transportation.

Lessons

Inexperienced skiers/snowboarders MUST take lessons. There is much to learn to be a good skier or snowboarder. Mr. Jim Anderson, a former certified Ski Patrol member, will be offering <u>free</u> ski lessons for students if they so choose. Please let Mr. Doran know if you need snowboard lessons scheduled. There may be an additional charge for these lessons.

Drop off and Pick up at New London High School

The bus trip will leave and return at the listed times. You can be assured that we make every effort to return to school on time. We will use the south side (staff) parking lot.

Obeying the Rules

The Ski and Snowboard Club is strictly voluntary so your child must accept responsibility for equipment and for obeying the safety and behavior rules and also any liability for accidents. The NLHS Ski and Snowboard Club is a drug-free alternative for students. The use of tobacco products, drugs or alcohol is strictly prohibited. Students who do not obey the rules will lose either their lift ticket or not be allowed to attend future trips with the rest of the group. The groups are chaperoned by school personnel and parents. Chaperons will be present on the hills and in the chalet.

Food

There is a chalet for skiers where they can to go warm up. It has items like pizza, burgers, french fries, hot chocolate, soda, etc. You are also allowed to bring your own food.

We may stop at a fast food restaurant for dinner on our way home from some trips. If your child does not pack a dinner please make sure they have money to pay for their meal.

Attire

Good common sense clothing is what is required to go skiing /snowboarding. This may include:

- HELMET- to prevent concussions and other head injuries.
- -WATER Proof **NOT** Water Resistant Ski/Snow Pants

-Warm socks -Gloves -Hat -Face Mask -Ski goggles -Jacket

-Loose fitting pants/jeans -Long underwear

-Dry clothes for after skiing

-NO SCARVES they can get caught in the lift

Extreme Weather

In case of extreme weather, such as below zero wind chills, a trip may be rescheduled.

In Case of Absences

In case of absences, transportation cost will <u>not</u> be refunded. The bus goes whether your child is on it or not and is figured in on a 25 member group. If you are unable to attend a trip please let Mr. Doran know so your cost can be adjusted. Adjustments will only be made for students who have a school-related activity conflict or family function conflict accompanied by a note from a parent prior to absence.
