

New London Athletic Hall of Fame Criteria

NLSD Hall of Fame Objective

- 1. To give deserved recognition to outstanding NLSD athletes, coaches, and supportive individuals of athletics.
- 2. To illustrate to current students and community members those individuals who have been instrumental in creating the outstanding Bulldog athletic tradition.
- 3. To promote continued interest in the Bulldog Athletic program via alumni and community members.

Nomination Process

- Nominees must be a graduate of New London High School or a member of the New London school/community who has made significant contributions to the success of the New London School District and its residents.
- 2. Alumni must be a graduate for a minimum of seven years prior to being considered for induction into the Hall of Fame.
- 3. Coaches must be retired from the position at which they served, or been actively coaching at NLSD for a minimum of 10 years before being considered for induction.
- 4. The athlete/coach must have conducted himself/herself in such a way as to reflect honor on the school and must have exhibited these qualities of character and standards of conduct consistent with their status as a role model to the community after graduation or retirement from NLSD.
 - a. NLSD reserves the right to remove any individual from the Hall of Fame for personal conduct which reflects discredit upon the school.
- 5. There are no restrictions placed on the maximum/minimum number of inductees. Nomination forms will be kept for 5 years and reviewed annually if candidate is not inducted.
- 6. State Champions and 1st Team All State will receive an automatic induction.

Nomination Process

- Nominations must be submitted via the Hall of Fame Nomination Form.
 - a. The form can be found on the district website or picked up at the New London High School.
- 2. Nominations are due by June 1st of each year.
