Since 2007 Rawhide Youth & Family Counseling has been providing counseling services to children, adolescents, adults and families struggling with a variety of behavioral and mental health issues. We serve both male and female clients of all ages. With our many years of combined experience, we compassionately and skillfully offer help to those in need. Our professional staff of therapists use a blend of therapeutic styles and approaches to address personal and family concerns. About the In-School Mental Health Program

Within the In-School Mental Health Program, students meet with a licensed Master's-level therapist to address personalized treatment goals. Counseling and psycho-education include a range of issues such as grief, anger, peer relationships, issues associated with depression and anxiety, and social isolation among others. Therapeutic services are offered within the school during the school day in an effort to meet the mental health needs of students while reducing the amount of time that students miss classes to attend outpatient therapy appointments in the community. In addition, services are offered to clients at our clinic on the Rawhide campus over the summer months and holiday breaks for continuity and consistency toward achieving treatment goals.

Costs

Rawhide Youth & Family Counseling is an independent organization and is not affiliated with the New London School District. Funding for the In-School Mental Health Program is not provided by the New London School District. Private insurance, BadgerCare and private pay are accepted for mental health services for students participating in the program. If you do not have insurance, but need mental health services, we encourage you to contact our office directly to discuss whether you qualify for a sliding fee option.

How to Make a Referral
