

BOARD ELECTIONS

POLICY STATEMENT

- A. The Board will be elected at the general election held on the first Tuesday in April of each year, following the procedure outlined for such election by the state statutes.
- B. Board members will be elected at large by a plurality vote of the electors of the district. Each member will serve a three (3) year term with a rotation cycle. This rotation cycle may change with any unanticipated resignation by a Board member. The rotation cycle is as follows:
 - 1. Two (2) Board members elected;
 - 2. Two (2) Board members elected; and,
 - 3. Three (3) Board members elected.
- C. Elected Board members' term of office will commence on the fourth Monday in April. Before taking office, Board members must sign an oath of office administered by the school district clerk.
- D. A student Board representative may be appointed by the Board of Education and will serve at the discretion of the Board.
