

STUDENT IN-SCHOOL SUSPENSION

POLICY STATEMENT

- A. A student whose disruptive behavior forces his/her temporary removal from the regular classroom may be assigned to in-school suspension. The student will be assigned to in-school suspension by school administrators and will be under the supervision of school personnel.
- B. The administration shall maintain procedures for in-school suspensions, including conditions under which credit will be given for work completed during the period of in-school suspensions.
- C. The District shall not discriminate in disciplinary measures, including suspension, on the basis of sex, race, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
