Counseling & Psychological Services, LLC has several Mental Health Clinics throughout the northern portion of Wisconsin. Mental Health Services such as Outpatient, In-home, In-School and Day Treatment therapy, and psychological assessments have been provided through our Rhineland, Ashland and Hayward clinics since 1999. In addition, the company provides social services such as supervised visitation, psychosocial rehabilitation services, mentoring and group work for parents and children. As an alumnus from New London High School, our Rhineland Clinical Coordinator is excited to return to the area and offer Mental Health Services in the New London community.

About the In School Mental Health Program

Within the In-School Mental Health Program, students meet with a licensed Master's-level therapist to address personalized treatment goals. Counseling & Psycho-education include a range of issues such as grief, anger, peer relationships, issues associated with depression and anxiety and social isolation among others. Therapeutic services are offered within the school during the school day in an effort to meet the mental health needs of students while reducing the amount of time that students miss classes to attend outpatient therapy appointments in the community. In addition, services are offered to clients over the summer months and holiday breaks for continuity and consistency toward achieving treatment goals.

Costs

Counseling & Psychological Services, LLC is an independent organization and is not affiliated with the New London School District. Funding for the In-School Mental Health Program is not provided from the New London School District. Private Insurance, Medical Assistance and Private Pay are accepted for Mental Health services of each student participating in the program.
