About Us

Kids Club serves Readfield families with children in grades 4K-4 by providing safe, enjoyable and affordable child care. Children are served a snack each day, are offered an opportunity for homework assistance and participate in a variety of age-appropriate activities including games, sports, arts and crafts, drama, music, special events and more!

Goals

To provide a flexible, developmentally-appropriate play and success-oriented curriculum which complements the home and school by encouraging physical, social, emotional, and intellectual growth and positive feelings of self worth of students in a group setting.

Staff

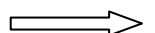
Kids Club staff members are committed to providing a warm, supportive environment to enhance the child's self image. We work to provide a student-to-staff ratio of 15:1. Background checks are provided for each employee and volunteer. Many staff members also work with students during the school day in a variety of ways.

Days in Session

Kids Club is offered Monday-Friday from 3:10-5:30, but does not operate when schools are closed. It is important to note that you can choose any combination of dates and times that work for you. Students who do not attend Kids Club on a regular basis still must have the emergency information completed and a note from their parents to attend. The note should be recorded in the student's agenda book, so the classroom teacher has knowledge of where the child is to go after school.

Fees for 2017-18

The fee schedule for the 2017-18 school year: Cost per student per daily attendance is \$5.00 with a weekly family cap of \$40.00. Families who qualify for Reduced Lunch will be charged \$3.00 per student per daily attendance and families who qualify for Free Lunch will be charged \$1.00 per student per daily attendance. **Late fees apply for all students.** The Kids Club coordinator and school office will send out monthly statements.

Kids Club Schedule: STARTS, Friday, September 1, 2017

Sign-in and Snack: 3:10-3:25 p.m.:

Students are entered into the computer system and signed-in for Kids Club. A healthy snack will be provided by the School District of New London's Food Service Program.

Breakout Groups/Homework/Academic Support, 3:30-5:30 p.m.:

Student Pick-up, 5:30 p.m.:

Parents may pick up their children anytime prior to 5:30, but no later. Parents must enter the building and sign students out. Signing-out requires the parent/adult to punch in the students ID number into the computer system. Parents will be given a card with their child's number as a reminder. If someone other than the parent picks up a child, the school must be notified by 3:30 p.m. on the day of change.

If a child is picked up after 5:30 p.m. parents will be charged an additional \$5 for each 15 minute period of time. Parents are asked to really work to ensure children are picked up by 5:30. It's a long day for children who look forward to being picked on time.

Transportation:

There will be no transportation provided by the school to or from Kids Club.
