ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDELINE 447.2 - STUDENT DETENTIONS

A. All schools:

- 1. Detentions may be administered as follows:
 - a. Teachers may detain students for minor classroom infractions.
 - b. Students may be placed in detention for inappropriate hallway or lunch period behavior.
 - c. Students may be placed in an after school detention by a principal for inappropriate classroom or general school behavior.

B. Middle and High Schools:

- 1. Detentions may be administered as follows:
 - a. Teachers may detain a student after school to correct a student's unacceptable behavior.
 - b. Students who are assigned detentions by more than one teacher must inform all teachers.
 - c. Students who have detention may not participate in cocurricular activities on any given day until the detention assignment has been completed.
 - d. Students may be detained by the administration for excessive tardiness, unexcused absence, or disciplinary reasons.
- C. Those students who receive detention for a discipline matter will receive credit for class work done during the detention.
- D. Reasonable efforts will be made to notify parents/guardians of student afterschool detentions.
