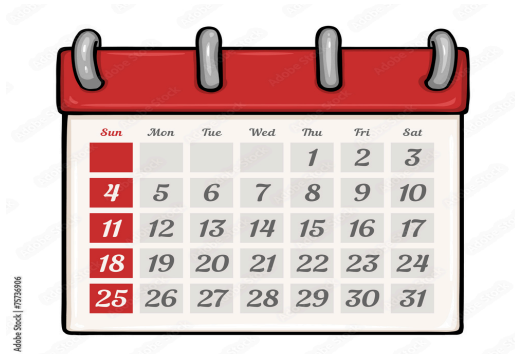

Art:

In art we are really starting to get into our creative side! 3rd and 4th graders have started making their own comics! We are looking into storytelling with our art and learning how to refine our artwork from a thumbnail (a word for sketches that comic artists use). 2nd graders are finishing up their dotted pumpkin project, where we were inspired by the famous alive artist Yayoi Kusama with her many dots! 1st graders are learning about the Art Element of Form and we are drawing Still Lifes (a setting of posed objects). Kindergarten is continuing their media exploration and finishing it up with clay! In Kindergarten, we will soon be moving onto The Poppy Project (a project affiliated with the American Legion Auxiliary).
