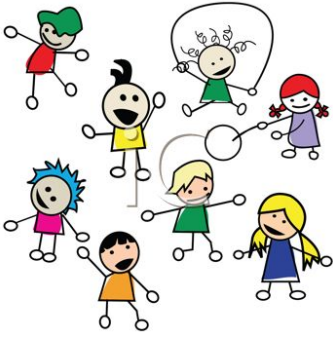


Child Development Days



What is Child Development Days?

A free preschool screening opportunity for children ages 2 – 4 ½ who reside within the School District of New London. The purpose of CDD is as follows:

1. Assess children's developmental progress.
2. Provide parents with awareness of available child care, community services, and medical/health resources.
3. Provide parents with awareness of child growth and development issues.

Who is Eligible to Participate?

1. Children who are ages 2 – 4.
2. Children who have not previously participated in Child Development Days.
3. Children who reside in the School District of New London.

When is Child Development Days?

The child development screening days are scheduled on the following dates from 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM by appointments:

October 13, 2020 (children's birthdays that are in April, May, June, July, August, and September)

January 26, 2021 (children's birthdays that are in October, November, December, January, February, and March)

Rescreening and those unable to attend previous dates will be done by appointment in February/March.

Where is Child Development Days?

The location for the Child Development Days screenings are held in the Early Childhood Classroom located at the Lincoln Elementary School, 201 E. Washington St., New London, WI 54961.

What Happens at Child Development Days?

Your child will be screened in a relaxed and friendly setting. While the screening is being conducted, parents will be encouraged to browse through our exhibit area where local agencies will provide information on child development, medical/health issues, as well as an awareness of community opportunities and services available for preschool children and parents. When the screening process is completed, an education professional will share the results with parents and address any concerns. The entire screening process is completed within approximately 45 minutes. Free gifts will be provided for children who participate in Child Development Days. Complimentary refreshments will also be served.

How Can I Register for Child Development Days?

Phone reservations for a reserved time slot for your child's screening can be made by contacting Linda at (920) 982-8447. While "walk in" children will be accepted for screening, parents are encouraged to call for a reserved screening appointment as children with reservations will be given a screening priority.
