On behalf of the Sugar Bush Staff I want to thank you for supporting all that we do to make Sugar Bush Elementary a great place to learn and have fun!

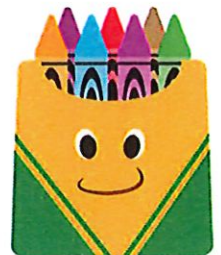

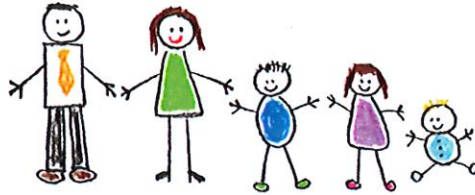

Armin Conradt presented Cameron with a check and an American Flag. Great job Cameron!

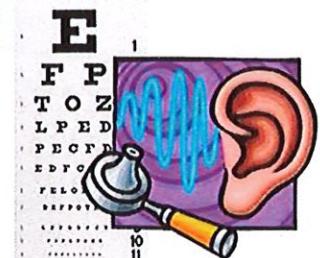


Volunteers Needed!

School Lunch Account—Important Notice

It is not the districts intent to deprive any student of a meal; however, the district has a financial liability by allowing family food service accounts to go unpaid. The practice causes the meal prices to increase for everyone else. In an effort to minimize credit problems and reduce the time and effort to deal with overdue accounts, no student or staff member will be allowed to charge against an account unless sufficient funds are available in the account.

Students will not be able to charge on the account again until the balance is restored to a positive number. Only a cheese sandwich will be given as an emergency meal along with a carton of milk and a fruit.

We also are aware that families ensue hardships from time to time. We encourage families to consider applying for our Free and Reduced Program. Part of our schools funding from the state is calculated by this program which, in turn, helps our school.
