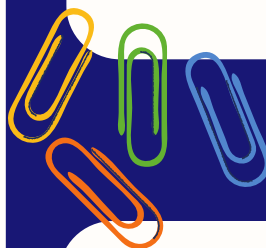

Guidelines may be adjusted during transitional weather periods.

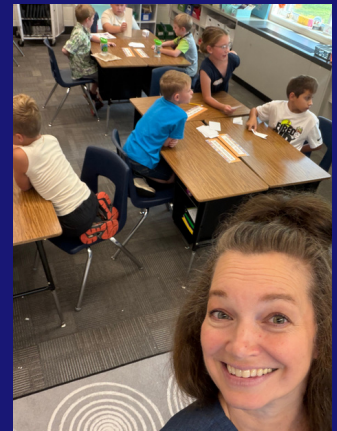
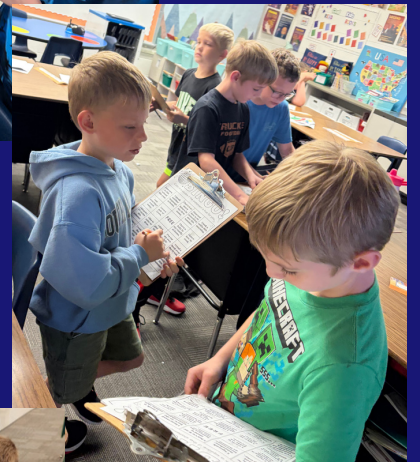
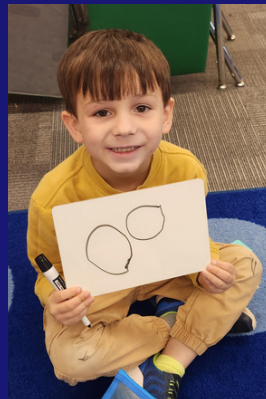
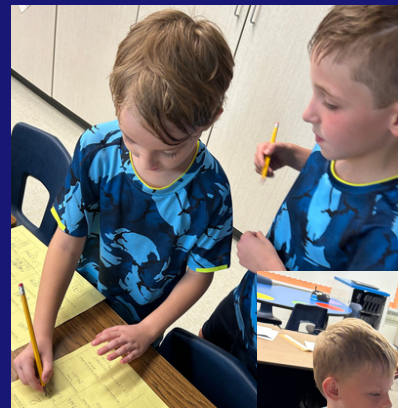
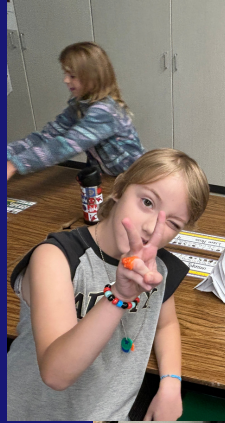
The school building can also get chilly during the day. Please send a long sleeved garment if your child(ren) tend to get cold.
