## Casa Hispana Scholarship Application

**Fall 2026 – Spring 2027 Academic Year**

**Hard Deadline: February 23, 2026 (Time: 11:59pm)**

At Casa Hispana, we believe investing in our youth is investing in our future. This scholarship supports and empowers Hispanic/Latino students in **Calumet, Outagamie, and Winnebago Counties (including New London)** who are pursuing post-secondary education.

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### Scholarship Awards

- **\$500** – Technical or Trade School
  - **\$1,000** – Four-Year College/University
- Several scholarships will be awarded for the Fall 2026 – Spring 2027 academic year*
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### Eligibility

You must meet **all** the following:

- Live in Calumet, Outagamie, or Winnebago County (New London included)
- Have at least one parent of Hispanic/Latino heritage
- Be enrolled for Fall 2026 and/or Spring 2027 (higher education institution)
- Attend a higher education school in the United States

*DACA and undocumented students are strongly encouraged to apply*

You are **not eligible** if:

- You are an F-1 Visa student
  - You are the child of a current Casa Hispana board, committee, or staff member
  - Been awarded twice
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## Selection Criteria

Scholarships will be awarded based on:

- Academic achievement
  - Financial need
  - Leadership, volunteer work, and extracurricular involvement
  - Applicant names will be changed to numbers/personal information redacted
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## Required Documents

- Current transcript (high school, college, or most recent school)
  - Proof of acceptance or enrollment in a post-secondary program
  - Two letters of recommendation (at least one academic) submitted via the online form (link in application)
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## Essay Questions

Write **400–500 words (each)** answering:

1. Why do you need and/or deserve this scholarship?
  2. How has your background and experience shaped your goals?
  3. What impact do you hope to make in your community as a Latino leader?
- In the above prompts the scholarship committee is looking for **your story**. Tell us who you are via your life experiences, involvements, and background upbringings)
