

**NEXT GENERATION ACADEMY
CHARTER SCHOOL**

ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

Next Generation Academy is open to all students who reside within the School District of New London as well as students attending the District through the open enrollment process who are assigned to the Next Generation Academy Charter School. Enrollment procedures are as follows:

1. Enrollment forms may be attained from the District office (901 W. Washington Street; New London, WI) or online: <http://www.newlondon.k12.wi.us/charters/nextgen.cfm>
2. Parents/guardians are invited to set up an individual meeting with administrators, Danielle Sievert (NLHS, 982-8420) or Megan Yeska (NLMS, 982-8532), to learn more about the Next Generation Academy.
3. If the Next Generation Academy receives less than 24 enrollment applications for any grade; all students will be admitted to that grade. If the number of students who apply to enroll in the charter school by the end of the state open enrollment date exceeds (24) students in any grade(s), seven through twelve, a lottery will be held for that grade on the second Friday following the close of the open enrollment window. This random lottery will determine which students will participate in the charter school and which students will be placed on an ordered waiting list.
4. Students may enroll and attend Next Generation Academy at any point during the school year as space permits in accordance with established guidelines. Students already enrolled in Next Generation Academy do not have to reapply in subsequent years. Siblings of current Next Generation Academy students and Next Generation Academy staff will receive enrollment preference and will be exempt from the lottery.
5. Special needs will be met according to the goals of the student's Individualized Education Plan (IEP).
6. A list of selected students will be published and parents of applicant students will be notified of selection status. In the event of a lottery drawing, students not selected for the school will be placed on a waiting list in the order that they were drawn. If any selected students decide not to attend, students will be added from the waiting list in the order that they were drawn. If Next Generation Academy does not fill all available seats, it will continue recruitment efforts until it reaches its enrollment goal.
7. Once accepted to Next Generation Academy, students will be expected to attend an interview to discuss their learning style and academic goals to build a personalized learning plan. It is imperative that both students and parents realize that Next Generation Academy provides a rigorous educational program within a flexible structure. Success within this model relies strongly on the student's motivation and on the degree of parental involvement.
