Reader's Workshop

We started our first unit, Interpreting Characters, this week. Our lessons focused on reading intensely to grow ideas. We also focused on retelling; either chronologically or by doing a synthesis retelling. We'll continue to practice this next week. Homework was assigned this week to practice writing long off a post-it. Way to write long and strong readers! Reading at home is imperative to becoming a better reader, so please make sure your child reads at least 20 minutes every night, records it on his/her reading log, and you verify that reading with a signature!

Math

We continue in Unit 1: Place Value and Multi-digit Addition and Subtraction this week. We took our first quick quiz, compared and rounded greater numbers, and now are working on adding and subtracting multidigit numbers. Look for unit vocabulary cards (in your child's zipper pouch in his/her binder) AS WELL as "Computation Methods" sheets. These sheets can help you understand the strategies (methods) that your child is using to compute. Your child will be bringing home homework almost daily; and MUST be completed each night. Please let me know if you ever have any questions about the day's work.

Spelling

This year your child will continue to use our developmental spelling program called, Words Their Way. Students have taken an inventory to see what spelling patterns they have learned and can apply. Students are grouped according to the patterns they still need to learn. Each week's words focus on a different pattern/rule of our spelling system. Remember to practice and discuss the words and patterns each week to be ready for the spelling test on Fridays.

Writer's Workshop

"Never let anyone tell you your own limitations. If you want something, go and get it; the only person who can stop you is yourself." We continue in our writing mini-unit which is focused on building our writing lives and reviewing introductory grammar. We are using our "me bags" to compose a "Three Favorite Things" shared and independent writing piece. Next week we'll complete our on demand writing pre-assessment and begin Unit 1: The Arc of Story (Realistic Fiction writing).


