## Mathematics Department Flowchart



- Three credits of mathematics are needed to graduate. Algebra taken in 8th grade counts as an elective credit, NOT as a math credit towards graduation.
- Algebra is the foundational course for all future high school math credits. Students taking Algebra in 8th grade need to maintain a minimum of a $\mathbf{B}$ average in their Algebra course in order to take Geometry their freshman year.
- It is recommended that students planning on attending a four year college or university take four years of math. University of Wisconsin schools require a math placement test before scheduling college classes. Your math progression should be based on your goals for life after high school.
- Students have the opportunity to earn Laude Honor Points with the following courses:
