**ALL CLASSES**

**MATHEMATICS**

\*\*All math classes require a calculator. Students enrolled in Consumer Math, Algebra, Geometry, or Advanced Algebra - Trig should have a scientific calculator (TI-30XII). However, if you plan to continue your mathematical coursework (Pre-Calculus, AP Calculus, AP Statistics), you may want to purchase a TI-84+ or TI-84+CE graphing calculator instead.
