



2020 - 2021 School District of New London Supply List

New London is proud to have the 1:1 Chromebook initiative where students will have access to computers on a daily basis. With an increase in concern with shared supplies, our supply list is minimized for the 2020-2021 academic year in response to Covid 19 pandemic. Students who qualified for Pack it Up for Kids in the past will receive a pre packed backpack from their building office at the beginning of the school year.

Chromebooks will be issued along with a charging cord and carrying case. It is expected that the chargers stay at home in a location where the child charges the Chromebook each night. This should be a location out of the bedroom and where parents can monitor.

Early Childhood and 4K

You may wish to have a set of basic pencil box supplies at home and at school in case of changes in instructional delivery.

- Plastic pencil box
 - 3-6 pencils
 - 24 pack of crayons
 - 2 glue sticks
 - Wide markers
 - Scissors
- 2 folders (one to be kept at school, one for transport of materials home)
- Backpack please label on outside
- Water bottle: this will be sent home daily to be washed
- Art shirt (in a gallon ziplock bag with name on it)

- Extra set of clothes for accidents or messes (in a gallon ziplock bag with name on it)
- Masks/face coverings
 - Students who do not have masks/face coverings will be issued one for use
 - Classroom schedule will include mask breaks
- Students will need to bring personal and pre wrapped snacks

Please label everything: Backpack (label on the outside), folders, extra clothes, art shirt, water bottle, etc.

Chromebook is NOT issued at this level.

Kindergarten - 1st Grade

You may wish to have a set of basic pencil box supplies at home and at school in case of changes in instructional delivery.

- Plastic pencil box
 - 3-6 pencils
 - Extra eraser
 - 24 pack of crayons
 - Wide markers
 - 2 glue sticks
 - Scissors
- 2 folders (one to be kept at school, one for transport of materials home)
- 2 notebooks
- 1"- 1½ inch 3 ring binder (not a trapper keeper)
- Headphones
- Backpack (please label on the outside)
- Water bottle: sent home daily to be washed
- Gym shoes to be left at school
- Art shirt (in a gallon ziplock bag with name on it)

- Extra set of clothes for accidents or messes (in a gallon ziploc bag with name written on it)
- Masks/face coverings
 - Students who do not have masks/face coverings will be issued one for use
 - Classroom schedule will include mask breaks
- Personal hand sanitizer is optional and allowed, however sanitizer and hand-washing breaks will be built into the classroom routine as well
- Students will need to bring personal and pre wrapped snacks

2nd grade- 4th grade

 - Hand held pencil sharpener
 - Colored pencils
 - 2 glue sticks
 - scissors
- 6 folders
- 5 notebooks
- 1"- 1½ inch 3 Ring Binder (not a trapper keeper)
- Headphones
- Backpack
- Water bottle: sent home daily to be washed

- Masks/face coverings
 - Students who do not have masks/face coverings will be issued one for use
 - Classroom schedule will include mask breaks
- Personal hand sanitizer is optional and allowed, however sanitizer and hand-washing breaks will be built into the classroom routine as well
- Students will need to bring personal and pre wrapped snacks

5th grade - 8th grade

You may wish to have a set of basic pencil box supplies at home and at school in case of changes in instructional delivery.

- Plastic pencil box
 - Pens (black or blue, and red for correcting)
 - Pencils/erasers
 - Colored pencils
 - 2 highlighters
- 5 plastic pocket folders
- 5 notebooks
- 2 1"- 1½ inch 3 ring binders (not trapper keeper)
- 7th and 8th grade math classes require a calculator. Teachers have them for classroom use, but it is recommended that students purchase their own for use throughout Middle School and into High School.
 - Scientific Calculator with Trig Functions (TI-30XII est \$10)
- Earbuds or Headphones

- Backpack
- Water bottle: sent home daily to be washed
- Masks/face coverings
 - Students who do not have masks/face coverings will be issued one for use
 - Classroom schedule will include mask breaks
- Personal hand sanitizer is optional and allowed, however sanitizer and hand-washing breaks will be built into the classroom routine as well.

High School

- Pens/pencils/highlighters
- Colored pencils
- Folders, notebook, binders
- Earbuds or headphones
- Wireless/portable mouse (if preferred)
- All math classes require a calculator, teachers have them for classroom use, but it is recommended that students purchase their own for use throughout the 4 years.
 - Scientific Calculator with Trig Functions (TI-30XII) for classes before Pre-Calculus (est \$10)
 - TI-84+ or TI-84+CE graphing calculator for Pre-Calculus, AP Calculus, and/or AP Statistics and beyond (est \$100)

- Safety glasses for any Technical Education and/or Science courses
- Masks/face coverings
 - Students who do not have masks/face coverings will be issued one for use
