ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDELINE 185 - BOARD COMMITTEES

The Board president, along with the recommendation of the District Administrator, and with the consent of the Board, may create special committees and appoint membership as deemed necessary and advisable to assist in the handling of specific problems and projects.

Special committees:

- Meet as needed or as directed by the Board
- Perform specific tasks
- Take no formal action

The Board president may appoint temporary committees that are designed to meet a current need. When the Board shall have acted upon the report or reports and recommendations of these committees, their work shall be considered completed and existence dissolved.

Temporary committees:

- Meet as directed by the Board
- shall consist of no more than three Board members
- shall discuss, gather information, or conduct research on a specific subject
- shall bring forth the analysis or recommendation to the Board
- Take no formal action
