

FULL-TIME STUDENTS

A student in the District will be considered full time if he/she:

- A. Is an elementary, middle, or high school student scheduled in classes for the entire school day;
 - 4-year-old kindergarten is a half-day program
- B. Has been evaluated by the District’s Individual Educational Team and has a prescribed individual plan that outlines what constitutes a full day for the student;
- C. Is participating in an alternative educational program or other program or curriculum modifications approved by the student’s parent/guardian and school district officials; (Students are being given more opportunities to participate in educational programs and activities that are offered off school grounds and/or that do not require the student to be in attendance at school the full school day. Such students may still be considered full-time students for state aid purposes.)
- D. Is a resident student attending public school in another school district under the full-time public school open enrollment law;
- E. Is enrolled or participating in approved alternative educational programs or program or curriculum modifications.
