

INTERROGATIONS – STUDENT

- A. If a situation arises in which law enforcement officers request permission to remove a student from class or school for the purpose of questioning, permission of the student’s parent or guardian and the building principal will be necessary for such questioning. County officials may, however, contact, observe, or interview a student at school without parental permission if the child is in need of protection or services as determined by the building principal or designee.
- B. In cases where permission is granted to law enforcement officers to question a student on school grounds, the building principal or designee shall be present during the questioning.
- C. This policy is directed at situations during the regular school day and does not necessarily pertain to co-curricular activities.
