SCHOOL SAFETY RESPONSE PLAN FOR LIFE-THREATENING SITUATION

School District of New London staff will utilize code signals through its intercom systems to staff members for the purpose of relating circumstances which have the potential to become life-threatening. The following codes have been established:

- 1. Medical Emergency.
- 2. Emergency Lockdown.
- 3. Hazardous Spill Emergency.

Medical Emergency signals a life-threatening medical situation is occurring within the building (i.e., cessation of breathing, uncontrolled bleeding, heart attack, unconsciousness, severe shock, etc.)

Emergency Lockdown is a non-medical emergency and relates to an extreme circumstance which has the potential of becoming life-threatening for one or more individuals within the building (i.e., armed individual or individuals within the building, etc.)

Hazardous Spill Emergency signals a hazardous waste spill has occurred which has the potential of becoming life-threatening for individuals in or around school buildings.
