Student Immunization Law - Age/Grade Requirements 2014 & beyond

Please check your child's immunization records to see what vaccines they may need to be compliant with state law for the 2015-16 school year. You may compare this list by checking your child's records on the school website at: www.newlondon.k12.wi.us - go to "Parents, Family Access". Log in, go to health information, and click on vaccinations. Staying up-to-date with immunizations will keep your child compliant with the state law.

***** It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to provide an up-to-date copy of their children's immunization records to the school health office. If your child receives any of the listed immunizations during the summer months or at anytime during the school year, please inform school with the immunization updates.**

The following are the minimum required immunizations for each age/grade level.

Pre K (2-4 years old)	4 DTP/DTaP/ DT	3 Polio	3 Hep B	1 MMR	1 Var
Grade K-5	4 DTP/DTaP/ DT	4 Polio	3 Hep B	2 MMR	2 Var
<u>Grades</u> <u>6-12</u>	4 DTP/DTa P DT/Td	4 Polio	3 Hep B	2 MMR	2 Var 1 Tdap

1. DTP/DTaP/DT vaccine for children entering Kindergarten: Your child must have received one dose after the 4th birthday (either , 3rd , 4th, or 5th) to be compliant. (Note: a dose 4 days or less before the 4th birthday is also acceptable).

2. DTP/DTaP/DT/Td Vaccine for students entering Pre K and grades 1 through 12: Four doses are required. However, if your child received the 3rd dose after the 4th birthday, further doses are not required. (Note: a dose 4 days or less before the 4th birthday is also acceptable).

3. Tdap means adolescent tetanus, diphtheria and acellular pertussis vaccine. If your child received a dose of a tetanus-containing vaccine, such as Td, within 5 years of entering the grade in which Tdap is required, your child is compliant and a dose of Tdap vaccine is not required.

4. Polio vaccine for students entering grades Kindergarten through 12: Four doses are required. However, if your child received the 3rd dose after the 4th birthday, further doses are not required. (Note: a dose 4 days or less before the 4th birthday is also acceptable).

5. The first dose of MMR vaccine must have been received on or after the first birthday (Note: a dose 4 days or less before the 1st birthday is also acceptable).

6. Varicella vaccine is the chicken pox vaccine. A history of chicken pox disease is also acceptable.

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SCHOOL COMPLIANCE TIME LINE

DEADLINE

1st day - Admission to school	September 1, 2015
15th day - Notice to parents	September 22, 2015
30th day - Exclusion for non-compliant students	October 14, 2015
40th day - Assessment report to Health Dept.	October 28, 2015
60th day - D.A. report	December 1, 2015
