Kid's Club Schedule: STARTS, Tuesday, September 1, 2020

Cost: Cost per student per daily attendance is \$5.00 with a weekly family cap of \$40.00. Families who qualify for Reduced Lunch will be charged \$3.00 per student per daily attendance and families who qualify for Free Lunch will be charged \$1.00 per student per daily attendance. Late fees apply for all students. The school office will send out monthly statements. Payments are due by the 15th of the following month. Please make checks payable to the School District of New London OR payments can be made online.

Student Pick-up, 5:30 p.m.: If a student is not picked up by 5:30 p.m., the emergency contact listed will be called. A \$5.00 charge for each late pick-up will be added on to your monthly billing statement.

Note: Parents may pick up their children at anytime prior to 5:30 p.m.

- ❑ Students who do not attend Kid's Club on a regular basis must have a note from their parents to attend. The note should be recorded in the student's agenda book/home-school communication book, so the classroom teacher has knowledge of where the child is to go after school.
- ❑ Students sign-in for Kid's Club during snack time. Parents sign students out when they pick up their child(ren). If someone other than the parent is picking up the child(ren), the school must be notified by 3:30 p.m. on the day of change.
- ❑ Kid's Club is in session only on days that school is in session. On vacation days or emergency dismissal days, Kid's Club will not be in session.
- ❑ All students must be picked up by 5:30 p.m. If a child is not picked up by 5:30 p.m., the Kid's Club personnel will make every attempt to contact the parents. If no parent or emergency contact can be reached, the police liaison will be contacted to insure the child's safety.

Transportation: There will be no transportation provided by the school to or from Kid's Club.
